Literacy & English

Listening and Talking

Developing skills through working with a talk partner and co-operative learning tasks across the curriculum. Participating in structured discussions during Book Talk sessions.

Reading

Book talk based around group reading books. Guided and independent reading comprehension based around class text 'Malamander'. Developing skills to analyse a text and use evidence to support comprehension answers.

Writing

Guided Non-Chronological Report writing based on "Big Cats" and then Sea creatures linked to our IDL.

Spelling

Continuing with a 2 week spelling focus and irregular words alongside this.

- Place value number structure and number bonds
- 4 operations (+,-,x) and \div) and strategies with some focus on multiplication and division


