

## Literacy & English

**Writing-** Speech Writing linked to IDL topic on Equality and Persuasive Writing linked to business IDL as learners explore their own enterprise projects.

**Reading** – Book talk strategies used for class choice of novel and group novels. Learners will extend these strategies within group reading sessions. Guided and independent reading comprehension based around class texts. We will develop skills to analyse a text and provide extended comprehension answers, using evidence from the text.

**Spelling** – Progressive Spelling patterns. Spelling investigations to recap spelling rules. Common Word Practise.

**Grammar-** Adjectives, Modal verbs, Colons, Inverted commas, Adverbial phrases, Complex Sentences, Alliteration, Repetition, Comparatives and Superlatives. Grammar will link to writing lessons. Consistency in using correct punctuation.

**Talking and Listening** – Book Talk Discussions.



## Numeracy & Maths



### Numeracy

- 4 operations (+, -, x and ÷). We will focus on developing confidence in choosing the best strategy to solve a problem.
- Fractions decimals and percentages.
- Basic Maths Facts –to develop quick recall of facts and strategies.

### Maths

- Money – calculating profit and loss, working out money problems using the four operations, taking part in budgeting activities, discussing the advantages and disadvantages of digital banking.
