Literacy & English

Listening and Talking

Developing skills through working with a talk partner and co-operative learning tasks across the curriculum. Participating in structured discussions during Book Talk sessions.

Reading

Book talk based around group reading books. Guided and independent reading comprehension based around class text 'A Pattern of Secrets'. Developing skills to analyse a text and use evidence to support comprehension answers.

Writing

Narrative writing based on the story "Stone Age Boy" and then Newspaper Report writing linked to the Easter story.

Spelling

Continuing with a 2 week spelling focus and irregular words alongside this.

Numeracy

- Place value number structure and number bonds
- 4 operations (+,-,x and $\div)$ and explaining and choosing appropriate strategies
- Word Problems
- Continued focus on quick recall of Basic Maths Facts

Maths

Data Handling – creating and interpreting Venn diagrams, Carroll Diagrams, line and bar graphs and pictographs.

Numeracy & Maths

Time — Reading digital and analogue time, 12 and 24 hour time and recording time in a variety of ways using analogue and digital.


