Listening and Talking

Developing skills through working with a talk partner and co-operative learning tasks across the curriculum. Participating in structured discussions during Book Talk sessions.

Reading

Book talk based around group reading books. Guided and independent reading comprehension based around class text 'The Boy Who Met a Whale'. Developing skills to analyse a text and use evidence to support comprehension answers.

Writing

Explanation writing based on "How a Robot Dog Works" and a Recipe.

Spelling

Continuing with a 2 week spelling focus and irregular words alongside this.

Numeracy

- Ongoing place value and Number ordering and sequencing
- Focus on choosing appropriate strategies to solve a calculation – including 'missing number' calculations. Revision of division strategies in particular.
- Link between multiplication and division
- Word Problems
- Fractions of amounts and making links with division. Placing fractions on a number line.
- Continued focus on quick recall of Basic Maths Facts
